ORDER OF THE GUADALUPE COUNTY STATUTORY COUNTY COURTS AT LAW JUDGES OF GUADALUPE COUNTY, TEXAS, FINDING AREAS ESSENTIAL TO OPERATIONS OF THEIR COURTS

The Guadalupe County Statutory County Courts at Law Judges of Guadalupe County, Texas, hereby find that the following are essential to the operations of their Courts:

- All County Court at Law Courtrooms;
- All Auxiliary Courtrooms used by Administrative Judges, Visiting Judges, or Constitutional County Judge in the exercise of their Judicial function;
- All Judges' Chambers;
- All Jury rooms;
- Court Administrators' and Court Reporters' offices;
- County Clerks' offices;
- All offices related to administration of the courts;
- Attorney consultation rooms;
- Break rooms;
- Restrooms (which are used by jurors, parties, and attorneys);
- All hallways, stairwells, elevators, or common areas in the Guadalupe County Justice Center used to access any of the foregoing and used for waiting areas for jurors, witnesses, and parties.

As part of these findings it is found that the hallways, common areas, stairwells, elevators, and restrooms are all used by jurors, witnesses, attorneys, prosecutors, parties and judicial personnel. Use of these areas is integral and necessary to the operations of our courts. In addition, jurors, parties, and witnesses often wait or are required to wait in hallways and common areas.
