TURN AROUND, DON'T DROWN



Over the last several weeks, Guadalupe County and surrounding areas, were hit with continuous rain. Causing flooding in many areas and roadways.

Please keep in mind that:

- 6 inches of fast moving water can knock over and carry away an adult
- 12 inches of fast moving water can carry away a small car
- 18-24 inches of fast moving water can carry away most large SUV's, vans, and trucks



Please always proceed with caution and never cross a roadway flooded by water, moving or not.
