Honorable Judges and Commissioners:

The unaudited and unadjusted Monthly Financial Report of Guadalupe County, Texas is submitted herewith for the period from **March 1, 2015 through March 31, 2015**. This report was prepared by the County Auditor in compliance with Chapter 114 of the Local Government Code (Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated).

The Monthly Financial Report is presented in three sections: **Budget Status**, **Financial Statements**, and **Schedules**. The Budget Status section includes the "Top Five" revenues with selected charts. The Schedule of Revenues shows adjusted budget, year-to-date collections, and the remainder of the funds to be collected. The Schedule of Expenditures for all departments shows the adjusted budget, the year-to-date activity, current encumbrance, and the remainder in the budget. Included in the Financial Statements are separate balance sheets for the General Fund and Road & Bridge Fund, followed by a Consolidated Balance Sheet. These statements report on all County funds. The Schedules section includes the sales tax collection by month received, debt service payments, and total outstanding debt.

This report is designed to provide a general overview of Guadalupe County's finances for all those with an interest in the County's finances at a specific point during the fiscal year. However, the reader should note that the report does not include those disclosures associated with, and usually made a part of, audited financial statements. #1 Property Taxes

The County is different from other forms of local government in that it has limited sources of funding. The main funding source, and the only funding source directly controlled by the Commissioners Court, is property taxes. In the General Fund, Current Property Taxes (Maintenance and Operations, M&O) represent 65.4% of all revenue. Please see the chart included in this report for historical budget and collections information.

#2 Sales Tax

Guadalupe County's 1/2 percent sales and use tax rate (.005) was effective January 1, 1988. Please see the chart included in this report for historical budget and collections information

#3 City Contribution to Hospital

The County pays to the city-county hospital (Guadalupe Regional Medical Center, GRMC) 8% of its General Revenue Tax Levy (general fund property taxes and sales tax) for indigent health care. The City of Seguin then contributes to the County half of this 8% (i.e. 4%). This amount is set in an interlocal agreement between Guadalupe County and the City of Seguin on an annual basis.


#4 Vehicle Registration (General Fund)

The Tax Assessor Collector remits a portion of the vehicle registration funds to the General Fund. This calculation is based on the Texas Transportation Code 502.1981. For more information on Vehicle Registration, please contact Tavie Murphy, Tax Assessor-Collector. Please see the chart included in this report for historical budget and collections information.

#5 Inmate Board Bills

In 2001, in order to accommodate the growth in inmate population, the County completed construction on the new Law Enforcement Center which added approximately 400 beds to the Adult Detention Center (Jail). This additional bed space in the County Detention Facility has been rented out to other governmental entities (local and federal) in need of housing for their inmates. This "renting of bed space" is referred to as inmate board bills.

Inmate board bill revenue does fluctuate and depends on the needs of other jurisdictions; this revenue is not secured or guaranteed for any budget period. Please see the chart included in this report for historical budget and collections information.









REFUNDING BOND, SERIES 2014
