## Job Duties Include:

- Interpret and apply Texas Commission on Environmental quality, Texas Health & Safety Codes and County regulations governing the application of OSSF (On-Site Sewage Facilities) and the other environmental and public health codes.
- Review application and engineered design to assure that proposed site plan and specifications meets all state and county rules and regulations.
- Inspects potential septic system sites in order to confirm the accuracy of site evaluation and septic system designs.
- Performs daily scheduled inspections of OSSF's.
- Use of field equipment during inspection such as hand held, electronic or automatic transit levels, GIS/GPS units.
- Investigate complaints; assist public with resolution of problem.
- May perform soil tests and evaluates the suitability of building lots for the installation of OSSFs.
- Represent department at legal proceedings.
- Reports illegal septic system installations and malfunctioning systems.
- Serves notice of maintenance contract expiration.
- Prepares and submits reports and records of duties performed into department database and to TCEQ.
- Performs such other duties as may be assigned.

Applicant must have a High School Diploma or GED, minimum of 2 years of experience in public or environmental health. Must be a current Designated Representative (D.R.) licensed through Texas Commission on Environmental Quality or obtain license within 1 year of employment and attend continuing education courses required to maintain D.R. license.

This position pays from \$25.54-\$26.83 per hour commensurate with experience and license status. Benefits include Medical Insurance, Paid Holidays, Vacation, Sick Leave and Retirement.
