**ORDER TO APPROVE
THE CREATION AND CHANGES OF VOTING PRECINCTS**

Now on this 13th day of May, 2025, the Guadalupe County Commissioners Court approved the creation and changes for voting precinct boundary lines pursuant to the Texas Election Code, Section 42.006(a) which states, "...a county election precinct must contain...not more than 5,000 registered voters" and Section 42.031(a), "During March or April of each odd-numbered year, each commissioners court shall determine whether the county election precincts comply with Sections 42.005, 42.006, and 42.007. The commissioners court may make that determination during March or April of an even-numbered year. Before May 1 of the year in which the determination is made, the commissioners court shall order the boundary changes necessary for compliance."

The number of active registered voters as of April 15 , 2025 in Precincts 208 and 415 have exceeded the maximum number as indicated in Section 42.006(a) above.

Precinct 208 has 7,175 registered voters
Precinct 415 has 6,142 registered voters

The map attached as Attachment "A" shows the boundary line changes for Precinct 208 and the boundary lines for the new Precinct 233.

The map attached as Attachment "B" shows the boundary line changes for Precinct 415, and boundary lines for the new Precinct 402.

Polling locations for the above precincts are any of the 38 County Wide Polling Places utilized by the County.

Voters living in the above precincts shall receive notification of these precinct changes.





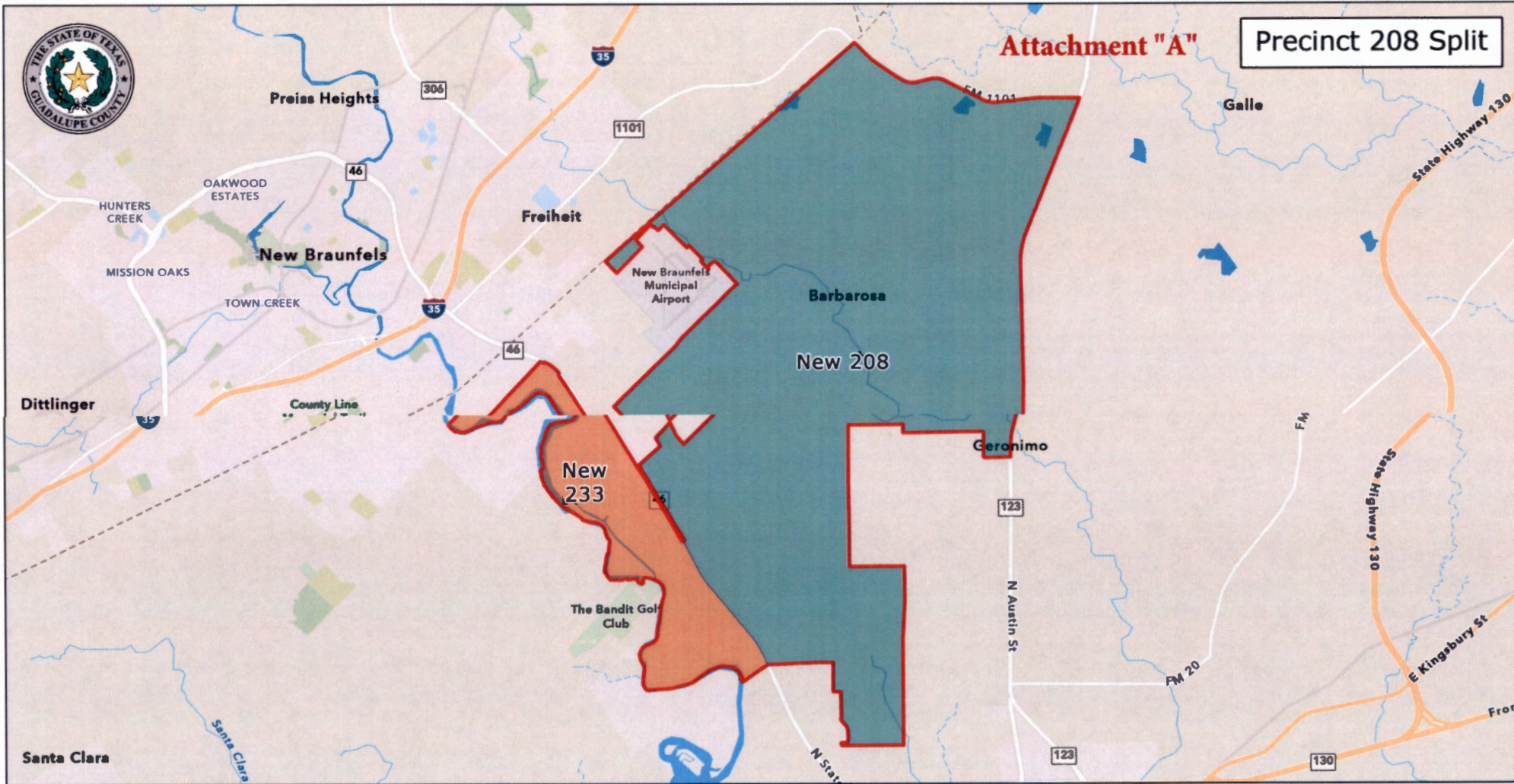
