Guadalupe County Bulk Clean-up Event, Saturday, May 16

GUADALUPE COUNTY, TX – Guadalupe County invites residents to take part in the County’s Bulk Clean-up Event scheduled for Saturday, May 16, from 7:30 to 11:30 AM at the Road & Bridge Department. The entrance to drop off items is at the intersection of Austin and North Guadalupe Street in Seguin. This is a free opportunity for residents to dispose of waste and help create a safer, healthier environment. Residents are asked to bring a photo ID or utility bill.

To help ensure an efficient flow of traffic, residents are asked to prepare in advance by separating items such as tires, scrap metal, and general debris.

The maximum trailer limit is 12’ to allow for safe access.

ACCEPTED ITEMS

- Trash (paper, plastics)
- Junk debris
- Furniture (sofas, tables, mattresses, etc.)
- Household appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers)
- Scrap metal
- Tire size must be less than 19.5” (without rims) – Limit 4. No rims attached. Tires must be separated from other bulk items & visible for quick removal.
- Dry paint
- Bagged yard waste
- Ceramic toilets must be in a cardboard box
- Refrigerators and freezers must be empty, and the compressor and freon must be removed

NOT ACCEPTED

- Hazardous Materials or chemicals (gasoline, used oil, liquid paints, acids, bases, anti-freeze, etc.)
- Batteries (Lead, NiCd, Lithium)
- Brush/Limbs
- Fencing
- Sheds

- Construction material & debris (asphalt shingles, insulation, sheetrock, etc.)
- Dead livestock/pets
- Junk vehicles, boats
- Oil-based paint
- No dump trailers
- No gas in mowers or equipment

County officials remind residents that illegal dumping is a crime that harms our neighborhoods and imposes an unnecessary financial burden on taxpayers. Keeping our county clean is a shared responsibility and everyone can help by properly disposing of waste.
