Guadalupe County Commissioner Engelke Selected as Alternate Presiding Officer

Guadalupe County, TX – Guadalupe County Judge Kyle Kutscher selected Precinct 2 Commissioner Drew Engelke to serve as alternate presiding officer for 2026. Engelke will serve as chairman over the commissioners court meetings if Judge Kutscher is absent for any reason.

Commissioner Drew Engelke is the longest-serving continued commissioner currently serving Guadalupe County. He was elected in 2018 and has served in various capacities, including managing county construction projects, representing county leadership, and remaining active on multiple boards and commissions throughout Seguin, Schertz, and the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization.

Engelke recently managed the remodel of the Elections Administration Office, improvements to the Adult Detention Facility, and repairs to the county Jail building. Current management of Precinct 2 projects includes the renovation and expansion of the Animal Control facility and the North Guadalupe Street Project, which is planned to expand county facilities, build an emergency operations center and warehouse, and enable the county to meet the growing needs of services for the expanding population.
