### County's Draft Major Thoroughfare Plan Available to Public

**Guadalupe County, TX** — Guadalupe County Commissioners Court has made the Draft Major Thoroughfare Plan available for public review and comment prior to considering adoption of the revised plan later this summer. The Major Thoroughfare Plan is a long-range planning tool for future roadways and serves as a communication tool between the County and its residents and developers to help guide the County's future roadway system.

Residents are encouraged to participate in the review of the Master Thoroughfare Plan from May 5 through June 5, 2026. Community feedback plays an important role in shaping the future of our area, and there are several ways to get involved. Residents can attend a public meeting, explore and comment on the plan online at [GuadalupeTX.gov](http://GuadalupeTX.gov), or visit one of the County's facilities to view a printed map and submit their input via the comment form.
