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**Guadalupe County Emergency Management Urges Flood-Affected Residents and Businesses to Submit Damage Reports** 

Guadalupe County, TX – The Guadalupe County Office of Emergency Management is encouraging all residents and business owners who sustained damage during the July 5th flood event to report it through the appropriate state systems: the **Individual State of Texas Assessment Tool (iSTAT)** for residents and the **Public State of Texas Assessment Tool (pSTAT)** for businesses and government entities.

As of July 10, 2025, Guadalupe County has received 45 iSTAT submissions, which include 41 residences and 4 businesses reporting damage. The City of Seguin has submitted 3 pSTAT entries and is currently working on two to three more.

Submitting damage reports through iSTAT and pSTAT is vital for helping local and state officials assess the extent of the damage and determine eligibility for potential state and federal disaster recovery assistance.

We urge all residents who experienced damage to their homes, property, or personal belongings to complete the iSTAT survey. Likewise, local businesses and government agencies should complete the pSTAT survey if they were impacted by the flood.

These surveys are quick, accessible online, and provide the data needed to support our request for disaster assistance.
