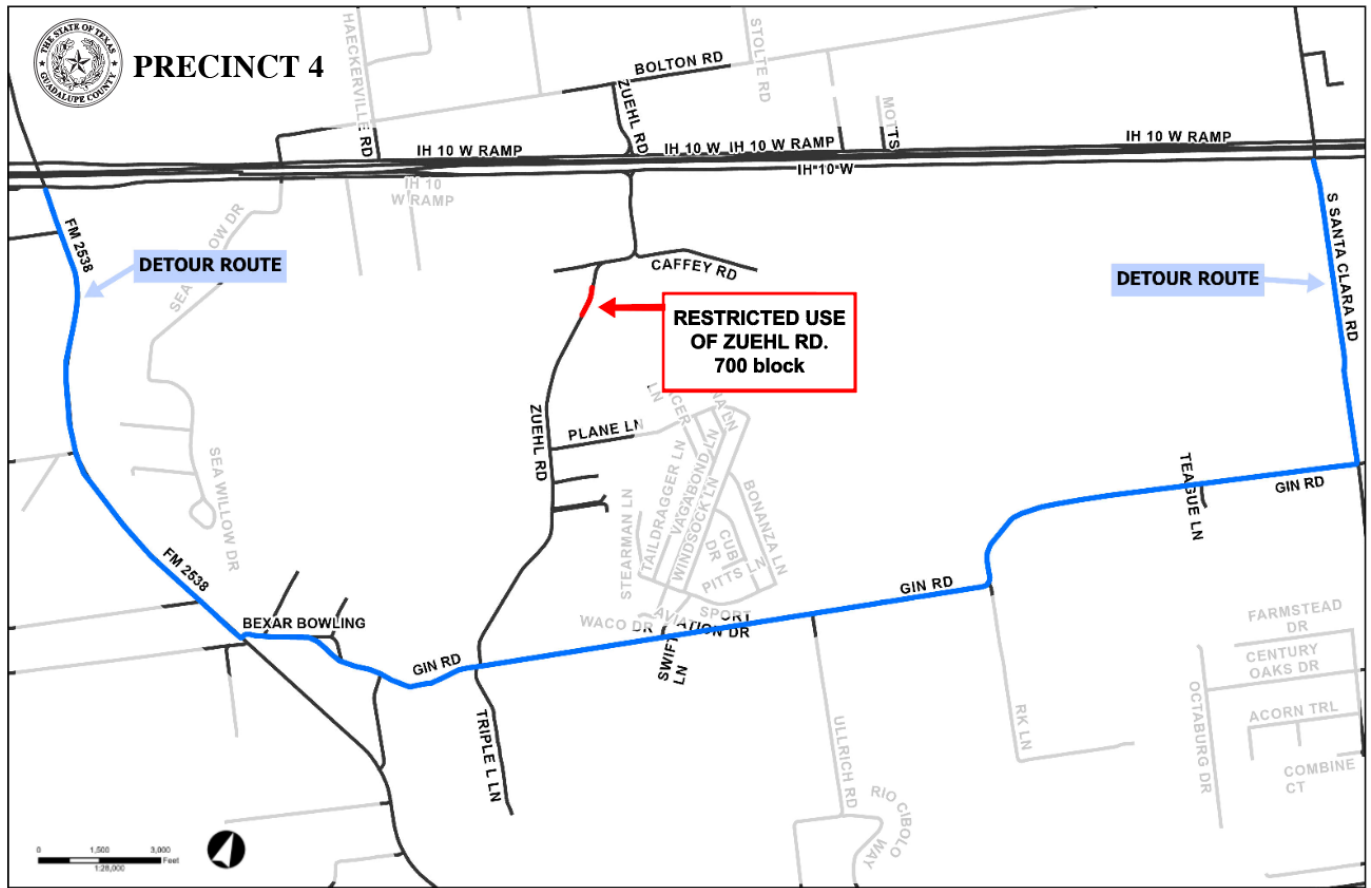

Restricted Use of 700 block of Zuehl Road in Precinct 4

GUADALUPE COUNTY, TX—The Guadalupe County Road and Bridge Administrator Doug Burnside determined the need for restricted use of Zuehl Road, approximately the 700 block just south of IH10 in precinct 4, due to extensive slope erosion from the July 4 flooding and overflow of Cibolo Creek. The extensive damage has made the roadway unsafe, and restricted use of the road is required until further evaluation can be completed. Traffic signs are in place to detour traffic to utilize surrounding roads such as FM 2538, S. Santa Clara, and Gin Road.

We ask all drivers to coordinate their commute accordingly. Thank you for your patience while we work on this portion of Zuehl Road.

- What:** The 700 block of Zuehl Road, maintained by Guadalupe County, was impacted by flood waters, eroding an area of the road deemed unsafe for use
- When:** Monday, August 18 – Wednesday, October 1
- Where:** 700 block of Zuehl Road in Guadalupe County, Pct. 4, just south of IH 10
