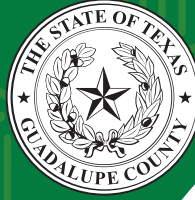

ACCEPTED

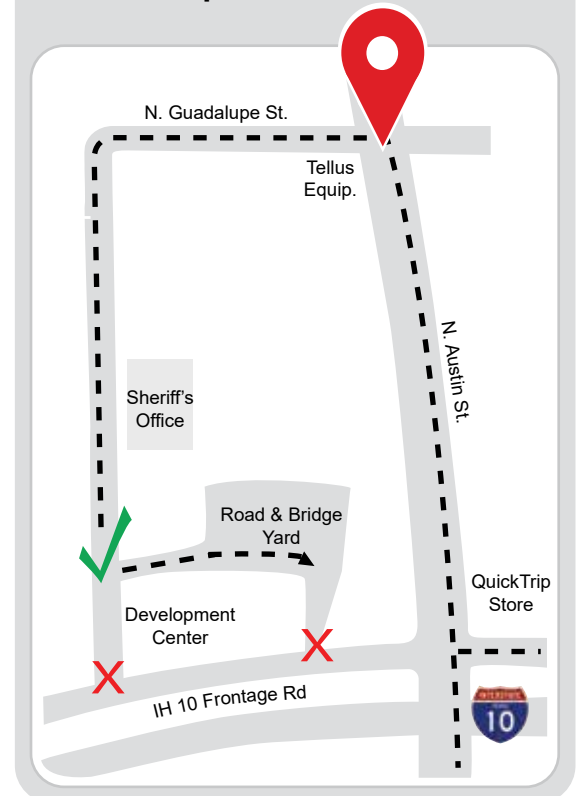
- Trash (paper, plastics)
- Junk debris
- Furniture (sofas, tables mattresses, etc.)
- Household appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers)
- Scrap metal
- Tire size less than 19.5" (without rims) – Limit 4
Must be separated from other bulk items & visible for quick removal
No rims attached
- Dry paint
- Bagged yard waste
- Ceramic toilets must be in a cardboard box



NOT ACCEPTED

- Hazardous Materials or chemicals (gasoline, used oil, liquid paints, acids, bases, anti-freeze, etc.)
- Batteries (Lead, NiCd, Lithium)
- Brush/Limbs
- Fencing
- Sheds
- Construction material & debris (asphalt shingles, insulation, sheetrock, etc)
- Dead livestock/pets
- Junk vehicles, boats
- Oil-based paint
- No dump trailers
- No gas in mowers or equipment
