

EXPUNCTIONS

Governed by Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Chapter 55, an expunction is the legal process for the removal and destruction of arrest and court records. Eligibility for this remedy is not automatic and is strictly defined by the specific circumstances of your arrest and case.

Below is a list of local agencies normally involved in the expunction process, any additional outside agency that has published your information concerning the arrest or charge in your petition should also be included.
