To Whom It May Concern:

The City of San Marcos, Hays County, Texas (City) is working with the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to establish a hazardous materials route within the City limits. The route designation would require that all vehicles carrying hazardous cargo travel on the designated route to their intended point of exit, rather than travel on local streets or roads that cross the San Marcos River.

Before a route can be designated by the FHWA, federal regulations require that the City contact political subdivisions within a 25-mile radius to make them aware of the route designation and to receive input regarding the change. Please accept this letter and the attached supporting documentation as notice of our request to designate a hazardous cargo truck route, to be signed and duly enforced throughout the city limits of San Marcos, Texas.


