Environmentex is conducting a Section 106 Review to assess potential effects of the proposed project on Historic Properties, i.e. properties that are listed or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. As part of this Section 106 Review, we are inquiring if you or your office has any knowledge of Historic Properties that may be affected by this project or wishes to comment on the potential effects of the proposed project on Historic Properties.

The client is proposing to construct a 145' (155' w/ appurtenances) monopole tower and associated equipment within a proposed 55' x 55' lease area (to be constructed within a 115' x 109' construction staging area), along with associated 30' wide access/utility easement. As part of this project, 30' in all directions beyond the proposed lease area and associated easements was reviewed.
