VA BENEFITS, ADDITIONAL SERVICES, AND/OR REFERRALS:

Guadalupe County Veteran Services Office

Mon - Fri, 8am-5pm Provide assistance on all VA benefits as well as community resource referrals. We have 3 computers onsite with internet access, a printer, camaraderie events, a Purple Heart walking track, bbq grills, a kitchen and meeting room. We also have vans to help drive veterans to their VA doctor appointments, driven by volunteers- call ahead for assistance. Texas Veterans Commission (TVC)
