Recognizing March 2026, as Arts in Our Schools in Guadalupe County

Whereas, every year in March, the American Alliance for Theatre & Education, the Educational Theatre Association, and the International Thespian Society partner for Arts In Our Schools Month to raise awareness of the value of theatre education and the benefits of the skills and processes developed through the arts; and

Whereas, theatre is an integral part of arts education and the arts have been part of life from the very beginning and are an inseparable part of the human journey, describing, defining, and deepening the human experience and adding depth and dimension to our environment; and

Whereas, all students participating in arts education courses benefit from the skills and processes developed through the arts and apply them across a variety of disciplines and settings, regardless of their intended career path; and

Whereas, participating in theatre contributes to students' development through heightened skills in listening, understanding human experiences, adapting to and respecting others' diverse ways of thinking, communicating, effectively analyzing nonverbal communication, reading, self-expression, imagination of humankind, creativity; and

Whereas, theatre helps develop self-confidence, boost self-reliance, and increase empathy and compassion for oneself and others; and

Whereas, as a creative outlet or as the first steps toward a professional career, theatre programs in Seguin and throughout Guadalupe County shape the future of our young people.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Guadalupe County Judge hereby designates March 2026 as Arts in Our Schools Month in Guadalupe County.
