Recognizing Telecommunicators Week April 12-18, 2026, in Guadalupe County

WHEREAS, in times of intense personal crisis and community-wide disasters, the first access point for those seeking all classes of emergency services and homeland security information is 9-1-1. The Guadalupe County Sheriff's Office Communications Center receives these calls, having emerged as the first and single point of contact for persons seeking immediate relief during an emergency. Guadalupe County Sheriff's Office dispatchers answered 20,608 calls on 9-1-1 in 2024; and

WHEREAS, Guadalupe County is celebrating April 12-18, 2026, as National Telecommunicators Week. This week, honors the Telecommunicators who respond to emergency calls, dispatch emergency professionals and equipment, and render lifesaving assistance to the residents of Guadalupe County; and

WHEREAS, the importance of recognizing and celebrating the hard work of these dedicated professionals at every level is immeasurable. 
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Commissioners Court of Guadalupe County proclaims the week of




