Whereas, Charlie Willmann met and married Patricia Ruth Oswalt Willmann; where they settled in Guadalupe County, Texas, and raised their family on the farm where he was born; and

Whereas, Charlie and Patty enjoyed a fulfilling life devoted to their family and community, raising three children and welcoming five grandchildren and five great-grandchildren; and

Whereas, together they raised cattle and award-winning pecans; the farm is still in the family, and he enjoys staying updated on its activities;


Whereas, Charlie Willmann is dedicated to serving his community and participated on various boards in Guadalupe County, including Guadalupe County Child Welfare Board, Guadalupe County Regional Medical Center Board, the Seguin Library Board, Texas Farm Bureau, Texas Agricultural Education & Heritage Center, and the Guadalupe County Pecan Growers to name a few; and

Whereas, Charlie Willmann served as Guadalupe County Commissioner Precinct 1 from 1988 to 1992; acted as county judge pro tem, and served as interim county judge from May 2012 to November 2012; and


